

New Utrecht Reformed Church to reopen sanctuary December 16

The New Utrecht Reformed Church Sanctuary building will be reopened on Sunday, December 16, 2018 with a Worship Service at the special time of 3 p.m. All are welcome to attend.

The landmark building, dating to 1828, has undergone stages to major restoration and repair, including a new shake roof, a new barrel-vaulted interior ceiling and upgraded electrical service. While more work needs to be done on the organ alcove, both the congregation and community are now able to worship in this historic sacred space. Please note that only street parking is available. After Service, there will be a time of fellowship (with coffee and cake) in the Parish House next door.

As part of the Sanctuary reopening celebration, New Utrecht Reformed Church will be hosting the annual Living Nativity on our front lawn, on Saturday, December 15, from 3 to 5 p.m.
